


# How do you connect the PlayStation VR (PSVR)?

In this article, we'll explain step by step how you connect the PSVR, the Virtual Reality headset of the Sony PlayStation, to your PS4. When you've gone through these steps, you'll be ready to get started with VR gaming on your console.

## What's included in the box?



The following parts are included with the standard edition of the PSVR (CUH-ZVR2)

- HDMI cable (1x)
- USB cable (1x)
- AC adapter + power cable
- VR headset connector cable
- VR headset (CUH-ZVR2)

- Processor unit
- PSVR stereo earbuds
- 5 PlayStation VR games
- PS VR camera


## Connect

---

We'll start off by connecting the PSVR to the PS4 and the TV or monitor. After, we'll set up the headset, so it's ready for use.

## Cables



1. Remove the HDMI cable of your PS4 from the PS4 and connect it to the processor unit.
2. Connect the PS Camera to the USB port at the back of your PS4 with the included USB cable. The ideal placement for the camera is 140cm from the ground.
3. Connect the included HDMI cable to the PS4 port of the processor unit and the HDMI OUT port of your PS4.

4. Connect the USB cable to the back of the processor unit and to the USB ports on the front of your PS4.
5. Connect the headset cable to the front of the processor unit.
6. Connect the power cable to the processor unit and the AC adapter. Plug the AC adapter into the socket. The PSVR is now connected.

## Tip

---

**Tip:** are you using multiple USB devices? In that case, you can connect a USB hub to the remaining USB port. That way, you can also charge your controller and connect your wireless headset.

## Setup

---

Now, we're all set to customize the PSVR to you. Make sure the TV and PlayStation are on.

## Get started

---



1. Press the activation button at the bottom of your VR headset. The tracking lights on the back will light up blue.
2. If necessary, your PSVR will now automatically download the latest updates.
3. Follow the steps on the screen to properly set up the PSVR for use.
